Forfás in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (5) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Industrial Development Act, 1993 (No. 19 of 1993), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Camera Tubes (Blank Detail Specification) Declaration, 1994.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Camera Tubes (Blank Detail Specification). The Schedule comprises the text of EN 113001 : 1991.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN 113001:1994 or as I.S./EN 113001:1994.

3. (1) The Standard Specification (Camera Tubes (Blank Detail Specification)) Declaration, 1984, is hereby revoked.

(2) Reference in any other standard specification to the Instrument hereby revoked and to Irish Standard 602 : 1984 (CECC 13001 : 1980) thereby prescribed, shall be construed, respectively, as references to this Instrument and to Irish Standard/EN 113001:1994.
